

Dane County Employee Metro Transit Pass Program: 2021-2022



Overview

Dane County supports sustainable commutes by providing a free unlimited ride Metro Transit pass for all employees upon request.

Current passes are valid from April 1, 2021 - March 31, 2022 and allow employees to ride the bus at any time. Using the bus to commute, get to meetings, and make personal trips is a great way to save money and support sustainability in Dane County!

Using Your Pass

Print your name and contact information on the front of the pass before the first use. Passes are not transferable and Metro Transit reserves the right to ask for ID when you use your pass.

Passes are for the personal use of employees only and may be confiscated if misused.

Lost or Damaged Passes

Please report lost, stolen or damaged passes to roundtrip@cityofmadison.com or (608) 266-7433. You will receive a replacement pass at no charge and your old pass will be deactivated.

Termination of Employment

Please notify us at roundtrip@cityofmadison.com if you leave your position with the County, so that we can deactivate your pass on the appropriate date. We work with Dane County to deactivate passes when an employee is no longer employed.

Emergency Ride Home (ERH)

If you regularly commute by bus, bike, carpool or vanpool, you may sign up for the Emergency Ride Home program with RoundTrip.

The ERH program provides sustainable commuters with up to six taxi vouchers per year, worth up to \$75 each, for use in cases of emergency such as personal or family illness when you are at work without a vehicle. Participants may now request vouchers *when needed*, from their phone or computer.
